SHRINERS HELPING NATURAL DISASTER VICTIMS

Shrine Family,

Shriners Hospitals for Children® is expected to admit several children in critical condition with burn injuries suffered in Sunday's volcanic eruption in Guatemala. The children are expected to be transported by the United States military today or late tonight, Tuesday, June 5.

Within 24 hours of the disaster, Shriners Hospitals deployed an emergency medical team from the Galveston Shriners Hospital to Guatemala to provide onsite evaluation and care. The team worked with Guatemalan and U.S. officials to secure approval to transfer those who required further treatment at Shriners Hospitals in the United States. A second team from the Boston Shriners Hospital is on stand-by to travel to Guatemala and provide additional support. Shriners Hospitals for Children stands ready to help other Guatemalan children if needed.

As you all know, Shriners Hospitals is uniquely prepared to respond to a tragedy of this proportion, having specialized pediatric burn hospitals. We have a deep history of mobilizing to respond to tragedies across the globe and have committed to help these children. We view ourselves as a global force for children and each and every day we bring love to the rescue to children around the world.



During this particular time of crisis, we have had tremendous support from the U.S. military and the U.S. Department of State in assisting us in transporting the children to Galveston Shriners Hospitals. This is largely due to the foresight of Shrine leadership to reach out to government officials to help pave the way for this type of emergency response after the fire in Guatemala in 2017.

I want to thank our go-team and professionals from both Galveston Shriners Hospitals and Headquarters, who have been working around the clock to make this a successful mission. I ask all of us to give our continued support to our go-teams and hospitals during this time of need.

We will continue to keep you posted as the events unfold. I am very proud of the hard work and dedication that all of you bring each and every day.


